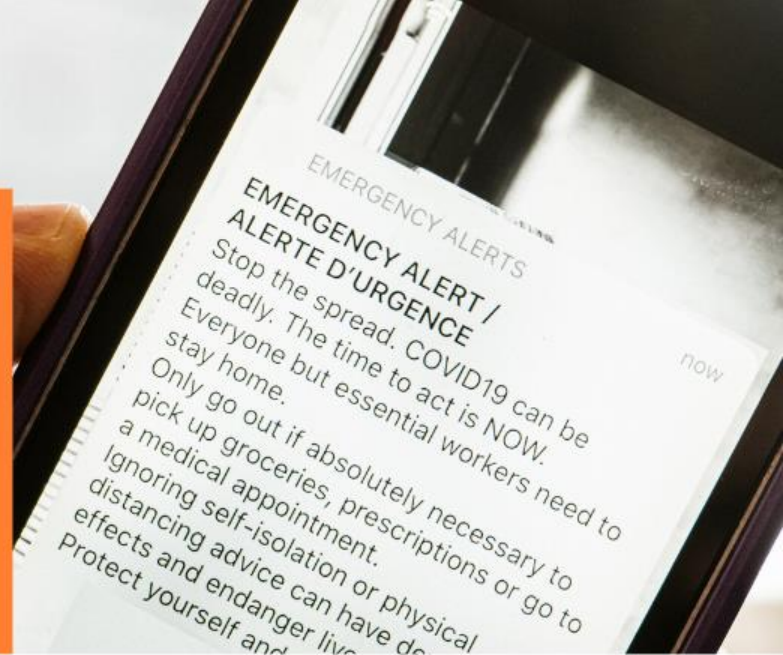

Context of this webinar

- Implementation of article 110 of the European Electronic Communications Code:

“By 21 June 2022, Member States shall ensure that, when public warning systems regarding imminent or developing major emergencies and disasters are in place, public warnings are transmitted by providers of mobile number-based interpersonal communication services to end-users concerned.”

The EECC

- 2 technologies to comply with this requirement
 - Cell Broadcast
 - Location-Based SMS

The EECC

EECC is a legislative mandate to make use of the telecommunications channel to alert the population.

BUT this doesn't stop here:

- Different alerting channels should be considered
- Public Warning Systems should be correctly used
- A clear strategy should be defined in advance
